Recent Projects Funded By Donor Dollars

Clinton Public Hospital Foundation <u>transferred</u> \$1,009,410.12 to the hospital in 2020-2021 to support numerous capital projects and the purchase of capital equipment for CPH.

While operating costs of Ontario hospitals are publicly funded, medical equipment and upgrades to hospital infrastructure often are not. Proceeds from our fundraising efforts, private donations and bequests allow us to make necessary purchases and upgrades to ensure quality local healthcare is available to our community and surrounding areas.
